In compliance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Emergency Response Act (AHERA) in the summer of 1998, we performed inspections of our school buildings for asbestos containing building materials (ACBM). The inspection findings and asbestos management plan have been on file in the school administration office since that time. The EPA requires us to perform re-inspections of the ACBM every three years and six-month surveillances each year for any change in condition. An accredited management planner reviewed the results of the re-inspections and recommended actions we should take to safely manage our buildings.

Inkster Preparatory Academy is in good condition and we will continue to manage as recommended by the accredited management planner. We plan on taking whatever steps are necessary to ensure your children and our employees have a healthy and safe environment to learn and work in. The results of the most recent inspection are on file in the school administration office. Everyone is welcome to view these anytime during normal school hours (Monday through Friday 8:00am-4:30pm)
